Unity Candle

Sand Ceremony

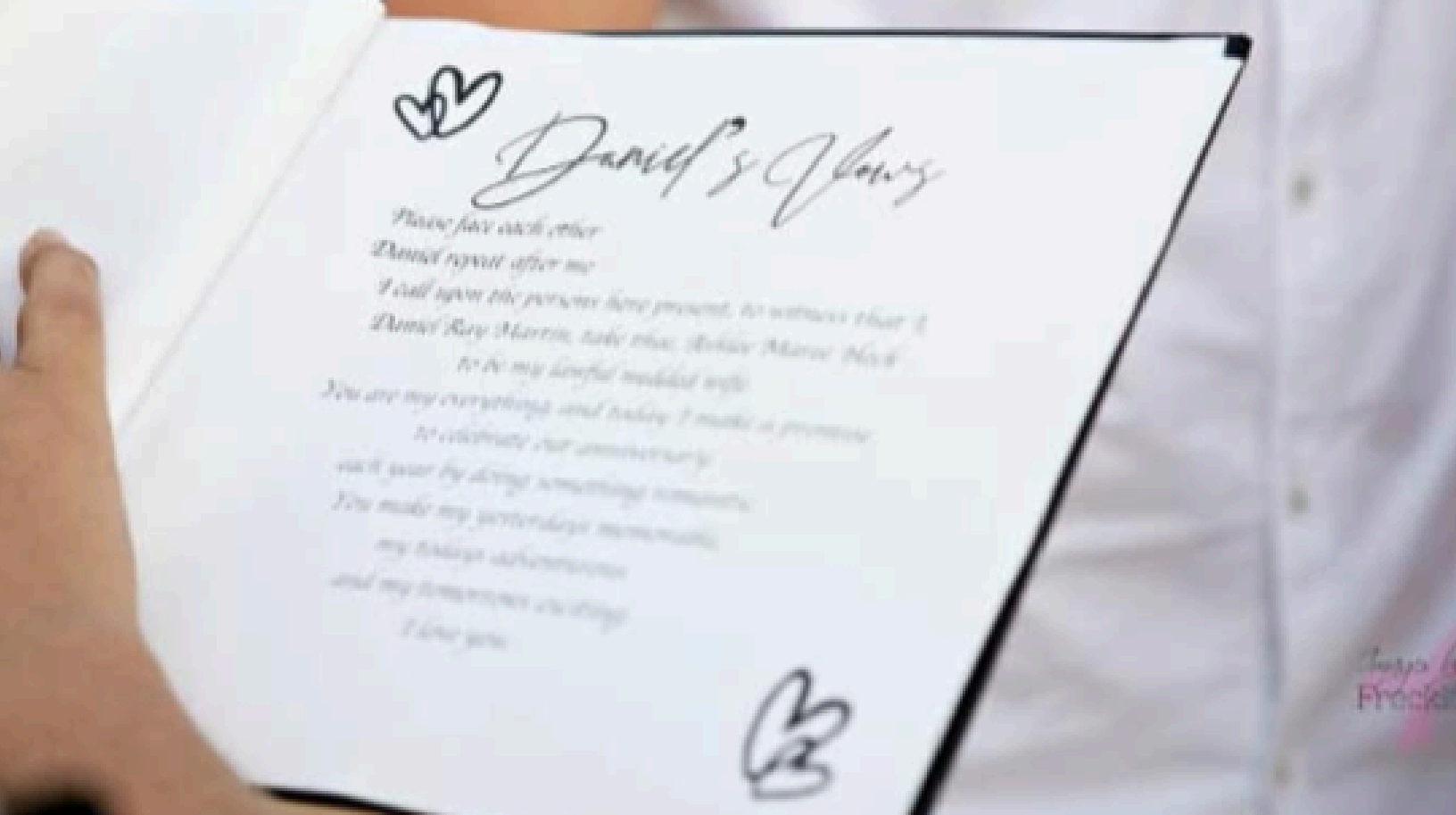
